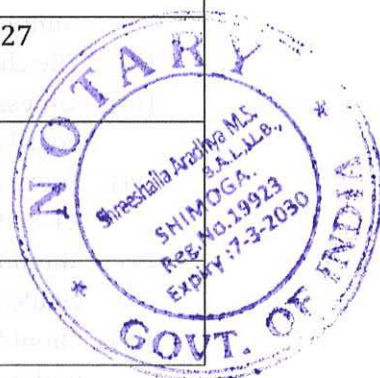

Conditions :-

- As per Children's Right to Education Act-2009 and Karnataka Education Act-1983 rules framed under the said acts, this private unaided school is registered and renewal is made to such classes as per registration. [Primary Education/Higher Education] 1 to 5th [1 to 5, 1 to 8, 6 to 8, 9 and 10 and also 1 to 10]. Except this the school authority is not permitted to additional classes or sections.
- School should function in accordance with the rules and regulations as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and Children's Right to Education Act – 2009.
- 25% of the of the seats is to be reserved to the children from Minority Group as per rules prescribed in Children's Right to Education Act – 2009. Schools coming under

R.T.E Act is empowered to fill-up seats under R.T.E quota [Government has formulated rules to enable the parents to get admission in the schools nearby their residence / locality and in case if there are government, aided schools of government, then they admit their children to such schools] in case there are no schools, then the private schools should take admission of such children in their school as per government allotment and provide primary education to them. There should not be any sort of discrimination to continue their education amongst the children.

4. The Government will release the fee relating to children admitted under R.T.E as stated in Condition No.3. Hence collection of any sort of fee from such children is strictly prohibited.
5. The school authority or School Management is strictly prohibited in respect of collection any sort of capitation fee or voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of admission or on a subsequent date.
6. School Authority / School Management should publicized the details of Tuition Fee so collected from the parents of children, in the website of the department and school notice board in accordance with State Government Circular No.ED:31:PGC:2019 dated 27-07-2019. Excess Fee should not be collected over the prescribed fee.
7. School Authority / School Management should take admission of the students within the date fixed by the Government.
8. School Authority / School Management should not refuse admission except following circumstances :
 - (i) Lack of Age Proof.
 - (ii) Caste, Tradition, Place of Birth, Language.
 - (iii) In case admission sought after expiry of late date fixed for admission
9. All precautionary measures should be taken in accordance with Right To Education Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules [Certificate/s is to be obtained from Fire and Building Safety Department and teaching should be conducted as per K.S.C.P.C.R. and N.C.P.C.R. guidelines].
10. The school authority / school management
 - (i) Should not withhold or oust out any child from its school who has been admitted to primary education and secondary education, unless and until said child completes the same.
 - (ii) The child should not be subjected to any sort of physical or mental harassment.
 - (iii) Unless child completes primary education, it is not required to pass out in any board examination.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education will get certificate as per R.T.E. Rule 21 and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) Should take admission of such children with special requirements / special challenges as per R.T.E. Act and Rules and also Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (vi) Should appoint teachers with requisite minimum qualifications as prescribed under R.T.E. Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules and also Government Orders relating to educational qualifications of Primary and High School teachers.
 - (vii) Salary and other perks being paid to the teachers will be in accordance with the Service Rules and conditions as prescribed by the Government and also in Government Circular. Provident Fund (PF) and E.S.I. and others payable to the teachers will be paid to their banks in accordance with law.
 - (viii) Should supervise that, the teachers are discharging their duties in accordance with Sec.24(1) of Teachers Act and R.T.E. Act and Rules and also Karnataka Education Act and Rules, Rule 17 and they are not engaged in private tuitions.
11. School should follow syllabus and books as prescribed by Education Board.



12. Should take admission of students, according to the infrastructure available in the school and also as per Section 19 of Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13. Should follow Rules and Regulations as prescribed under Sec.19 and appoint required departmental staff in accordance with the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
14. Should not open or engage in unauthorized conducting of classes / sections (branches) either in the school premises or outside.
15. Should not handover the school premises either day or night to any sort of commercial or political activities.
16. Should not handover the school premises to any person, group or society for their use or benefit.
17. Should get the Books of Accounts audited from a Chartered Account and submit it to Deputy Director / Block Education Officer within end of June every year.
18. Should follow local language (Kannada Basha Neethi-2016) as per Government Circular.
19. School Authority / School Management and Teachers must function in accordance with R.T.E. Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
20. School Authority / School Management should follow the Rules, Regulation and Instructions given by the Government and Department, without fail.
21. Should up-date school information in accordance with rules in S.A.T.S by the end of March every year.
22. In case, if there is any sort of violation of any of the above conditions by the school, then School Recognition will be cancelled as per R.T.E. Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act, 1983.

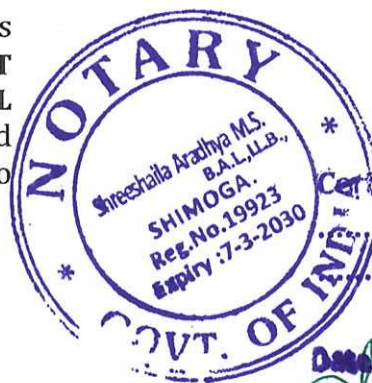
